

Peace House is a charitable organization dedicated to ending family violence and abuse through education, outreach, support services, and shelter. In 1992, the shocking murder of a woman by her estranged husband in a Park City parking lot energized community leaders to do something about domestic violence. They formed a Domestic Peace Task Force, and in 1995 the Peace House shelter became a reality.

For the first few years, Peace House operated entirely with volunteers. Today, the shelter is a state-licensed facility with trained staff on site 24/7. We continue to rely on a cadre of volunteers to supplement the small paid staff.

In the years since it began as a shelter for victims of domestic violence, Peace House has evolved to include community education and awareness programs designed to reduce the violence and abuse in our communities. We also provide many support services to victims outside of the shelter.

Money raised through the resale of gently-used jewelry, handbags and scarves at our annual Bling Fling Boutique goes directly to maintaining the Peace House shelter, keeping it safe and warm for families who turn to us for safe haven. Funds also are used to replenish the pantry with food supplies and cleaning products.

Your donations to Bling Fling in 2017 helped raise over \$50,000. These funds went towards helping an abused woman receive clinical therapy free of charge, provided new shoes for a child who fled to the shelter with his mother, helped a seventh grader understand what bullying is and where to go for assistance and much, much more.
